SUBJECTS AUTHORISED TO PROCESS



The Data may be processed by employees of the Company belonging to the corporate functions assigned to the pursuit of the aforementioned purposes, who have been expressly authorised to process them and who have received appropriate operating instructions.

TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA TO COUNTRIES OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION



The Data may be transferred to entities established in third countries, i.e. outside the European Union and the European Economic Area, deemed suitable by the European Commission pursuant to Article 45 of the GDPR or subject to the signing of the Standard Contractual Clauses (SCC) adopted or approved by the European Commission pursuant to Article 46 paragraph 2, letters c) and d) with the possible provision of "additional measures" to ensure a level of Data protection substantially equivalent to that required by EU law.

RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT - COMPLAINT TO THE SUPERVISORY AUTHORITY

By contacting the Data Controller by sending an e-mail to privacyconsumer@liujo.it, the data subject may exercise the rights recognised by Articles 15-22 of the GDPR, and in particular, may ask the Data Controller for access to the Data concerning him/her, their rectification, integration or deletion, as well as the restriction of processing in the cases provided for by Article 18 GDPR.



Furthermore, in the event that the processing is based on consent or on contract and is carried out by automated means, the data subject has the right to receive the Data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, as well as, if technically feasible, to transmit them to another Data Controller without hindrance.

The data subject has the right to object at any time, easily and free of charge, for reasons related to the particular situation, to the processing of Data in cases of legitimate interest of the Data Controller.

Data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority in the Member State where they habitually reside or work or in the State where the alleged infringement occurred.
